For purposes of determining eligibility for potential scholarships offered by the University, applicants must provide documentation of Mexican origin. Applicants may submit a copy of their own documents or their parent's or grandparent's documents. Acceptable forms of documentation: Visa, birth certificate, or passport. Additional forms of documentation will also be reviewed.

### Qualifications

The Institute for Mexicans Abroad (IME) of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in partnership with Arkansas Tech University is offering scholarship opportunities to students seeking degrees on both the Russellville and Ozark campuses. All scholarships are awarded competitively and are based on academic performance and financial need.

Applicants must:

1. Be Mexican or of Mexican origin
2. Be ineligible for any other type of scholarship or financial aid
3. Be enrolled as a full-time or part-time graduate or undergraduate student
4. Possess a GPA and college exam scores indicative of potential for success

While the award amount may vary, the scholarship has a maximum potential of \$5,000 per academic year. Scholarships are renewable based on a semester review and continued financial support by the Mexican Consulate.

Applicants under Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) status will be given preference. Applicants of Mexican origin who are also citizens of the United States must complete a FAFSA to determine financial need.

Students who receive funds will be given priority consideration for renewal by maintaining good academic and disciplinary standing, and completing their approved course load each term. Student awards may be renewed up until the term in which the student earns their highest attempted degree.
