Graduation Requirements

A candidate from the Associate of Applied Science in Occupational Therapy Assistant from Arkansas Tech University-Ozark must have successfully completed the requirements of this program, and must have earned an overall grade point average of at least 2.5. All fieldwork requirements must also have been successfully met. The student is responsible for applying for graduation according to university guidelines included in the Arkansas Tech University- Ozark Campus Catalog.

It is each student's responsibility to make sure that they have completed the requirements for graduation. The Associate of Applied Science Degree in Occupational Therapy Assistant, Regional Campuses, reserves the right to initiate changes in the program as deemed necessary for maintaining quality education in this field.

The following degree requirements must be successfully met in order to apply for graduation:

1. Successful completion of 28 hours of pre-requisite coursework
2. Successful completion of 35 credits of OTA core curriculum
3. Successful completion of 3 level I fieldwork experiences
4. Successful completion of 2 level II fieldwork experiences
5. Students must complete Level II fieldwork within 18 months following completion of the didactic portion of the program.
6. Successful completion with passing grade of the Pediatric, Adult, and Final OT Practice exams with a 75% or better on each exam
7. Program progression with a GPA of 2.5 or better
8. Good academic and behavioral standing
9. A student must earn a minimum of 30 credit hours taken from Arkansas Tech University.
10. Before any transcript is issued, the student must have paid any debt owed the University.
