Build A Kit. Make A Plan. Be Prepared.

Should a natural disaster, severe weather conditions or other unforeseen emergency occur, you may need to be self-sufficient for a short time. We encourage all students to have an emergency supply kit to meet your personal needs. Items for the kit can be gathered easily and the kit should be stored in your room where you can grab it during an evacuation.

RECOMMENDED ITEMS TO INCLUDE IN A BASIC EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT:

- Large backpack to hold your supplies
- Battery radio / NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert and extra batteries for both
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Personal hygiene items
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- Sturdy hiking boots or other shoes
- Extra clothes, including rain gear
- Packaged/non-perishable snacks/food
- Reusable water bottle
- Prescription/OTC Medications & Glasses
- Emergency phone numbers for your family and an out-of-state contact

ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO CONSIDER ADDING TO YOUR EMERGENCY KIT:

- Copy of medical insurance card
- Whistle, Multi-tool, and Can Opener
- Sleeping bag or warm/emergency blanket
- Feminine supplies
- Paper and pencil
- Portable backup battery/power bank for mobile devices
- Dust masks to help filter contaminated air
- Books, cards, non-electric games, puzzles or other activities to pass the time
- Plastic sheeting/duct tape to shelter-in-place
- Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from ready.gov

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
