Title: Student Support Hours Policy

Faculty Senate proposal:

Student hours are designated times during the week in which faculty are available to meet with students outside of scheduled class times for academic advising, academic guidance, mentorship, and support. Each faculty member is expected to schedule six student hours per week. Student hours should be spread across different days and times to accommodate various student schedules and can be a combination of inperson, virtual, drop-in, and by appointment. Student hours may be allocated proportionally to the type of classes being taught. For example, a faculty member with six credit hours of face-to-face classroom instruction and six credit hours of online/HyFlex instruction could be expected to schedule three in-office student hours and three virtual student hours per week. Student hours should be included in the course syllabus and posted in an easily accessible location (e.g., on/near office door).
