

Arkansas Tech University Spirit Squads ATU Dance Team Tryout Information and Requirements for the 2023-2024 Academic Year

Thank you for your interest in the Arkansas Tech Spirit Squads!

Our mission is to promote school spirit, unity and pride as dancers, spirit raisers, ambassadors and athletes. The ATU dance team promotes and spreads school pride in and out of uniform by supporting our athletic teams as well as university and community organizations. As student-athletes Dance Team members are held to a high-standard in the classroom and are expected to model good sportsmanship, character and team-building skills.

The ATU dance team consists of 14 scholarship members and performs a variety of jazz, hip hop, and pom style dances at all football and basketball home games. Members of the ATU dance team are scholarship athletes and will receive a \$725 scholarship per semester. \$25 of this scholarship is to be used for the Tech Fit fee.

As you consider becoming a member of the ATU Dance Team, please review the information below regarding the requirements and time commitments that are mandatory for each member of the Dance Team.

Tryout Requirements

- Incoming Freshmen
 - Must submit a copy of your acceptance letter to Arkansas Tech University with your tryout application.
- Incoming Transfers
 - Must submit a copy of your acceptance letter to Arkansas Tech University with your tryout application.
 - Must have a 2.3 cumulative GPA at your previous institution. An unofficial transcript listing a current cumulative GPA must be submitted with the tryout application
- Current ATU Student Requirements
 - Must be enrolled as full-time student (or required hours for graduating senior status)
 - o Be in good academic and disciplinary standing with the University
 - Must have a 2.3 cumulative GPA. GPA will be checked after the tryout application has been submitted.

Time Commitments

- Athletic Games
 - All home football games.
 - All home women's and men's basketball games.
 - All home volleyball conference games.
- Practice
 - Four to Five days a week for 2 hours.
 - Times for dance practice for Fall 2023 will be determined once the team is selected.
 - Typically practice is held M-F, 3:00-5:00 pm
 - Conditioning: 2 times a week. Expected to be completed outside of practice times.

- Academics/Events
 - Study Hall: 2 hours a week. If your GPA falls below a 3.0 at midterm this increases to 4 hours a week.
 - Special Events: Orientation events, Welcome Week, Family Weekend, Homecoming events, parades, University events, public appearances, etc.
 - Community Service- 10 hours per semester

ATU Dance Team Tryout Process

The tryout process for the ATU Dance Team is a multiple step process. Please see below for an overview of the process including optional/mandatory events and submission dates.

Application

- All applicants must complete and submit the Tryout application by March 24, 2023 at 5:00 pm CST.
- There is a \$30 tryout fee that must be paid when the application is submitted.
- The application for the ATU Dance Team is available on the Arkansas Tech Spirit Squad Website.

- Please be prepared to submit height, weight and measurements as part of the application process. While this information will not be used during the selection process, it is necessary to order uniforms.
- All applicants are required to submit proof of insurance to participate in the tryout process.

Round 1

- There are two options to complete Round 1 of the tryout process
 - Dancers can attend the interest clinic held on Saturday, March 11, 2023 from 9:00 am-12:00 pm.
 - Dancers can submit a video showcasing their skills by Friday, March 24, 2023 at 5:00npm.
- Dancers will indicate on the application which option they will choose to complete for their Round 1 Tryout. While the method you chose to complete Round 1 of tryout will not affect your selection, attendance at the Interest Clinic is preferred and highly encouraged.
- Applicants that are invited to participate in Round 2 of the tryout process will be notified no later than **Monday, March 27, 2023**.

Interest Clinic

- An in-person Interest Clinic will be held on **Saturday, March 11th, 2023.**
- Applicants should register for the Interest Clinic on the spirit squad website
- Interest Clinic Attire
 - Please wear spandex, shorts, leggings, or skort with a sports bra and t-shirt or tank top
 - Bring jazz shoes and tennis shoes
 - You may wear your hair up or down
 - Makeup is not required but encouraged

Video Submission- Skills Assessment

- All video submissions are due March 24, 2023 at 5:00 pm CST
- Applicants will email video link if they do not attend the March 11 Interest Clinic
- Videos should be uploaded to YouTube as an unlisted video. Links should be emailed to atuspiritsquads@atu.edu. Be sure to include your full name in the body of the email.
- Professional editing is not required or expected. Please be sure that your entire body can be seen for the full length of the video. Submission should be a continuous video with no editing. Please announce each skill before you complete it. We suggest having a friend or family member start and stop the music for your sample dance so you do not have to run back and forth.
- Attire for Video Submission
 - Please wear black spandex, shorts, leggings, or skort with a black sports bra and solid color t-shirt or tank top
 - o Jazz shoes and tennis shoes as needed
 - You may wear your hair up or down
 - Makeup is not required but encouraged
- Please demonstrate the following skills:
 - A sample dance (minimum of one minute showcasing jazz, hip hop, or pom style dance)
 - Single & double turn on both legs (a triple turn may be included if you're able)
 - \circ $\;$ Minimum of three pirouettes in a la seconde, finished with a double turn
 - o Calypso
 - Right, Left, and Center Splits (film right and left splits from the side)
 - Right, Left, Center, and Switch Leap
 - o Turning Disc

- Tilt Jump on preferred leg
- 2 Eight Counts of High Kicks
- Preferred: Headspring, Kip up, back handspring, front walkover, back walkover, or Aerial
- o Any other technique/skills you would like to showcase

Round 2

- Round 2 of the ATU Dance Team tryout process is an in-person tryout which will be held **Saturday & Sunday, April 1-2, 2023.**
- Applicants that are invited to participate in Round 2 of the tryout process will be notified no later than **Monday, March 27, 2023**.
- In-person tryouts will be held on the Arkansas Tech Campus.

Tryout Attire

- Please wear a black sports bra, black spandex, tan jazz shoes, and skin tone tights. The majority of ATU Dance team uniforms are midriff. It is important that you feel comfortable dancing in this style of attire.
- ATU Dance Team members perform in stage hair and make-up to ensure their features can be seen from the stands. It is important that you feel comfortable dancing in this style. Stage Hair and Make-up includes the following:
 - Hair must be completely down and styled.
 - Full Makeup is required.
 - The ATU Dance Team wears the lip color "Raisin Rage" by Revlon. New applicants are welcome to wear our lipstick color, but it is not required.
 - False eyelashes should be worn except for dancers with eyelash extensions.
- To create a unified appearance and not distract from the team image, body piercings, tattoos larger than 3x5, and extreme hairstyles or colors are not acceptable at tryouts or for selected members of the team. Your collegiate appearance will be evaluated as part of the tryout process.
 - All tattoos larger than 3x5, or any tattoos on the face or neck, are required to be completely covered. Covering should be secure and not come off during performances. Dancers are required to provide their own tattoo coverings.
 - There is not an ideal body type for ATU Dance Team members and our main focus is the health and dance ability of all applicants.
- Only stud earrings may be worn for ear piercings, no other jewelry will be permitted.

Required Technique

- Single & double turn on both legs (a triple turn may be included if you're able)
- Minimum of three pirouettes in a la seconde, finished with a double turn
- Calypso
- Right, Left, and Center Splits
- Right, Left, Center, and Switch Leap
- Turning Disc
- Tilt Jump on preferred leg
- 2 Eight Counts of High Kicks
- Preferred: Headspring, Kip up, back handspring, front walkover, back walkover, or Aerial

In-Person Tryout Agenda

- Saturday, April 1, 2023
 - 9:00 am-12:00 pm: Tryout part 1
 - Applicants will be taught the Fight Song, a college-style routine and three sideline chants.
 - Applicants will have an opportunity to warm up, practice required skills while receiving feedback from the coach, and practice the material learned.
 - Applicants will be divided into their tryout groups and will have the opportunity to practice with their group.
 - All applicants, including returners, will have a one-on-one interview with the coach.
 - Applicants will receive their tryout time for day two.
 - 12:00-1:00: Lunch break
 - 1:30-5:00: Optional Practice Time
 - Applicants will be able to practice all tryout material and ask questions about the tryout process
- Sunday, April 2, 2023
 - 9:30am-until finished: Tryout Part 2
 - Applicants can warm up and prepare for their tryout in the waiting area.
 - Groups will enter one at a team at their tryout time. Each applicant in a group will be asked to complete the required technique, one at a time. Each group will then perform the fight song and tryout routine together. One of the three chants taught will be randomly called and the group will perform the chant together.
 - After the group has completed the tryout process, dancers may leave campus and wait for results to be posted.
 - Team selection will be posted to the Arkansas Tech Spirit Squad website no later than 2:00 pm.
 - If selected for the ATU Dance Team there will be a MANDATORY uniform fitting for all new members at 2:30 pm in Hull 132.
- Monday, April 3, 2023
 - 4:00 pm: MANDATORY team meeting
 - Attendance can be in person or via a webex link. Location and a webex link will be sent out on Sunday afternoon.
 - New members can have a parent or guardian attend with them if they would like.

Virtual Tryout Process

- While an in-person tryout is preferred, we understand that some applicants may need to participate in a virtual tryout for Round 2. Applicants will indicate on the application if they need a virtual tryout
- Athletes joining virtually will be able to participate in every component of tryouts. Please see below for the details of a virtual tryout.
 - All links will be provided on the first day of tryouts. Applicants should have an appropriate area that is large enough to complete all components of tryouts.
 - The judges must be able to see your entire body (head to toe) while performing.
 - There should be no interruptions from friends or family members.
 - \circ To ensure a timely tryout process, athletes must ensure they have a strong internet connection.
 - Applicants will need to provide a device which the music for fight song and the tryout dance can be played. A family member or friend should be ready off-camera to start and stop the music when prompted during the tryout.

Tryout Attire

- Please wear a black sports bra, black spandex, tan jazz shoes, and skin tone tights. The majority of ATU Dance team uniforms are midriff. It is important that you feel comfortable dancing in this style of attire.
- ATU Dance Team members perform in stage hair and make-up to ensure their features can be seen from the stands. It is important that you feel comfortable dancing in this style. Stage Hair and Make-up includes the following:

Virtual Tryout Agenda

- Saturday, April 1, 2023
 - o 9:00 am: Tryout part 1
 - Applicants will receive an email which includes YouTube links to teaching videos of the Fight Song, a college-style routine, and three chants
 - Applicants will also receive a time and zoom link for a scheduled one-on-one interview with the coach.
 - One-on-one interviews with the coach will fall between 1:30-5:00 pm.
 - Please find a quiet area with no distractions to complete the interview.
 - You may interview in your dance practice clothes.
 - A zoom link and tryout time for Day 2 will also be included in the email.
- Sunday, April 2, 2023
 - Tryout Part 2

- Applicants will join the zoom meeting 10 minutes prior to their allotted time.
- Applicants will be let into the zoom meeting and will perform all the required technique, the Fight Song, the tryout routine and a chant selected at random by the coach.
 - Please see the video submission instructions from round 1 for a list of required technique that must be performed.
- Team selection will be posted to the Arkansas Tech Spirit Squad website no later than 2:00 pm.
- If selected for the ATU Dance Team there will be a MANDATORY uniform fitting at 2:30 pm. You will be emailed a link for a virtual fitting, if a trip to campus is not possible. You must have a measuring tape available for use.
- Monday, April 3, 2023
 - 4:00 pm: MANDATORY team meeting
 - Attendance can be in person or via a webex link. Location and a webex link will be sent out on Sunday afternoon.
 - New members can have a parent or guardian attend with them if they would like.
