- 3. Assessment Dr. Austin explained the departments should start the curriculum change process with reviewing assessment outcomes. This information should be included in the curriculum proposal as rationale for the change requested. Any new program

proposals should come to Dr. Austin to enter into the HLC Review System to determine if substantive change paper is needed. Dr. Austin also explained that HLC considers a substantive change to have occurred when the curriculum has changed by 25% or more during the period between HLC reviews. Individual course changes, as well as program changes are cumulative. Dr. Austin is logging changes between major HLC reviews (4-6 years). Programs that reach 25% changes in that period may need to file substantive change paper work with HLC.


