Dates: May 21 - May 27, 2025

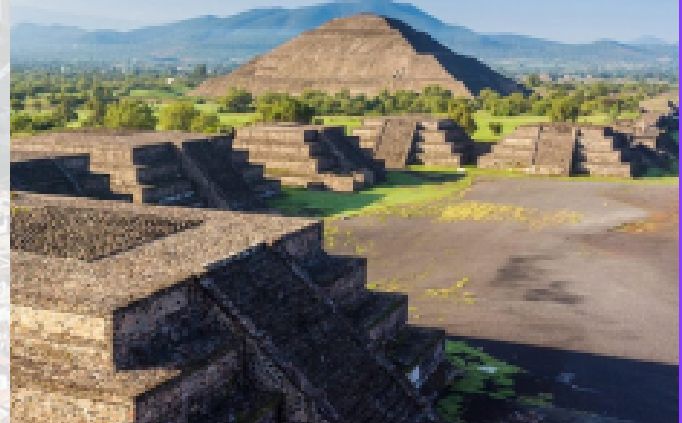
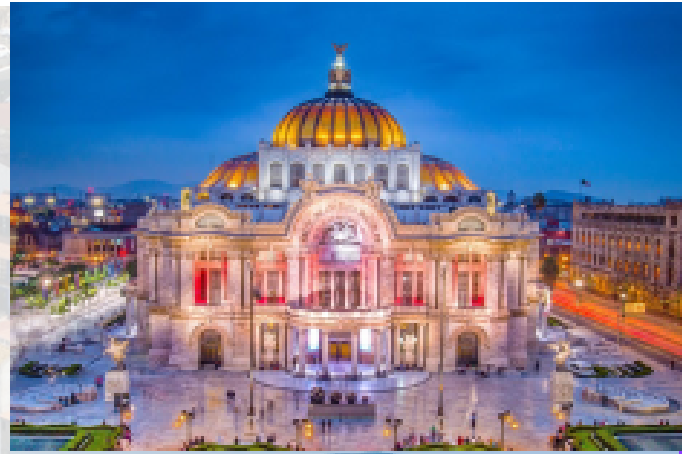
